Hosted by the Dataw Island Women's Golf Association, better known as DIWGA around the island, the annual benefit raised more than \$10,000 for Beaufort's Keyserling Cancer Center, and \$100,000 since the tournament began in 2002.

More than 140 Dataw residents participated in the unique "around the board" tournament with all registration fees and hole sponsorship fees donated to the Keyserling Foundation.

Donations were also raised at the post-golf cocktail party, raffle and silent auction. As in years past, this year's event also featured a theme modeled after the classic board game "Monopoly," complete with Dataw resident Walker Henry playing the role of Mr. Monopoly.



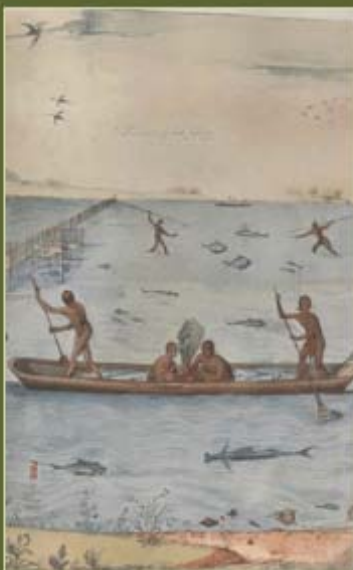

The 25,000 sq. ft. facility houses a state-of-the-art linear accelerator, as well as other computerized hardware and software to ensure

that cancer patients receive the latest and best in radiation treatment.

Dataw Island History – Why 'Dataw'?



The name 'Dataw' is said to be derived from the legendary giant King Datha, whom the Spanish learned of from Francisco Chicora, an Indian captured in 1521. Legend tells us that King Datha grew so big because of the magical herbs he ate. The meaning of the name Datha was thought to be "Greenwood."

Over the years, there have been eleven different spellings of Dataw, based on historic documents. A 1698 Proprietary Grant used "Datha," the earliest spelling in the English record. In 1701 it appeared as "Data" in a King's Grant. The now official designation is "Dataw Island."
